- Documentation required




Remote Patient Monitoring



Solutions Elusive


- Single-payer models

Bill running to create formulary









- More state legalization

- Auto & billing trends




CURRENT STATE OF LEGALIZATION












POSSIBLE STATE OF LEGALIZATION



- Has medical, could add recreational
- Medical and recreational marijuana legal
- Pending medical and recreational
- Medical marijuana legal
- Pending medical marijuana only
- Limited-purpose medical marijuana legal

Medical marijuana bill failed



SUMMARY OF STATE ACTIONS

Include on PDMP

Opioids

- Replace opioids for chronic pain
- For opioid use disorder/withdrawal

Location

- Home cultivation
- Tenant protection for users
- "Open Container Law" for marijuana

Use

- Allow for expanded or any conditions
- Allow smoking for medical use

Prohibit employment discrimination for medical marijuana use





SUMMARY OF STATE ACTIONS

- Increasing legal age for recreational use to 25
- Potency limits placed on all marijuana products
- Health warning on medical marijuana products
- Medical marijuana allowed in schools
- Allow medical marijuana for minors
- Residential marijuana agriculture





OF PARTICULAR NOTE

Require workers' compensation to reimburse

 Kansas, Maine, New Jersey, New York, Vermont

Exempt workers compensation from reimbursement

Kentucky

Repeal all legal use of marijuana

Massachusetts – HB3531

Urges slow legalization to consider impact in other states

Illinois HR 157

Legalizes medical marijuana for animals

Workers' Compensation Board:

Minimal risk of prosecution by federal authorities

Insurer
definition

insurers

Prescriber did not meet medical necessity test



MINNESOTA



Department of Health

Added "intractable pain" as eligible condition

Department of Labor

Will not treat medical marijuana as illegal substance



MAINE



Bourgoin v. Twin Rivers Paper:

June 2018

Maine Supreme Court vacated Appellate Court decision Requiring employer payment forced them to violate federal law



NEW JERSEY

Pro-marijuana lobby efforts increasing



Watson v. 84 Lumber:

Payer refused to reimburse due to federal illegality Court concluded medical marijuana was reasonable & necessary

Court ordered reimbursement for medical marijuana

Magic Mushrooms

- The next grass roots drug!
- CA: 2018 Attempted a ballot initiative
- Denver, Colorado: Muni ballot initiative to decriminalize possession
- Oregon: 2020? ballot initiative for medical use
- lowa HF 249 Legalize psilocybin, ibogaine and MDMA (ecstasy, "Molly") for medicinal use
 - First-of-its-kind legislation
 - Limited support





OPIOID TRENDS


- Reduction in prescribing rates
- Opioid prescribing limits
- Medical marijuana as potential alternative
- Declining overdose death rates from prescription opioids
 - · Deaths from street opioids are increasing
- Increased abuse of drugs used to treat substance abuse disorder




OPIOID PRESCRIBING LIMITS











OPIOID PRESCRIBING LEGISLATION

90+ bills in state legislatures

- Day limits for acute pain
- Patient disclosures or agreements
- Warning labels or caps on pill bottles
- Mandatory urine drug screening
- Co-prescribing naloxone
- Requiring insurers to cover detox services
- Workers' comp death benefits for overdose death for related opioids

Federal

- John McCain opioid addiction and prevention act
- S 419 requires the FDA to revoke one opioid authorization for each one approved

New York & Tennessee: bills that would unwind opioid limits & prohibit any prior authorization for opioids
